To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report No. 13, the Police Department has investigated the situation and found that a school bus driver who lives at Corcoran Park takes the bus home in the evening and parks in the area. Traffic regulations forbid the parking of commercial vehicles on city streets between the hours of 2 A.M. and 5 A.M. The Police Department has been instructed to patrol the area and enforce the regulation. It should be noted, however, that several of the streets in the vicinity of Corcoran Park are unaccepted ways and therefore, the Police do not have jurisdiction.
