Cornelius Hickey, 89, Winchester physician

Cornelius S. Hickey, M.D. of Winchester died Saturday at New England Medical Center after a brief illness. He was 89.

Born in Roxbury and raised in Charlestown, he graduated from Boston Latin School in 1926 and Tufts Medical School in 1932.

He was a resident of Winchester for the past 53 years.

He served his internship at Cambridge City Hospital and his residency at Boston City Hospital.

He went on to specialize in ophthalmology, studying at Indiana University as well as Boston Eye and Ear.

He worked as a general practitioner for a few years, serving as city physician for the city of Malden.

Dr. Hickey was in practice for 55 years before retiring in 1987.

He was a member of the

American Academy of Otolaryngology and Ophthalmology, the American College of Surgeons, and the American Board of Ophthalmology.

He belonged to the Clover Club of Boston and the Knights of the Holy Sepulchre. He was a longtime parishioner of St. Mary's Church in Winchester.

Dr. Hickey was the husband of Madelyn E. (Keefe). He is survived by two sons, Neil of Sudbury and Kevin L. of Worcester; a daughter, Madelyn M. Pocoski of Melbourne Beach, Fla.; and three grandchildren.

A funeral Mass will be celebrated tomorrow at 11 a.m. at St. Mary's Church, Winchester.

Burial will be in Wildwood Cemetery, Winchester.
