- WHEREAS: This City Council was saddened upon learning of the death of Richard Rowland Stebbins, a certified public accountant for more than half a century and former senior partner in the Boston Accounting firm of Shaw and Stebbins; and
- WHEREAS: Richard Stebbins was a well-known yachtsman, and avid bluefish angler in Buzzards Bay and, spent many summers sailing from his home at Wings Neck, Pocasset, with friends and family in his sailboat built by the O'Day Fiber Glass Boat Corporation of Fall River, where he had been treasurer for many years; and
- WHEREAS: Born in Dallas, Texas, Richard Stebbins attended St. Paul's School in Concord, N.H., graduated in 1931 from Harvard with a bachelor of arts degree, and moved to Boston in 1939, then to Medfield where he served two five-year terms on the park and planning board and was treasurer and vestryman of the Church of the Advent; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Stebbins then moved to Cambridge where he worked very hard as a volunteer treasurer of the Cambridge Art Association; being such an art enthusiast, he really put a lot of time into this; and
- WHEREAS: A former trustee for the Hillcrest Remedial Reading School, Mr. Stebbins had also been a member of the Harvard Faculty Club, the Harvard Club, the Somerset Club, the Dedham Polo and Country Club, the American Institute of Accountants and the Massachusetts Society of Certified Public Accounts; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Stebbins leaves to mourn his two sons, Richard and Daniel, two daughters, Gertrude Bartlett and Edith Sweeney, and eight grandchildren, all who will miss him very much; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record extending its heartfelt sympathy to all of the members of Richard Rowland Stebbins' family at this hour of loss and misfortune; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the family on behalf of the entire City Council.
