MAYOR RUSSELL

WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of the Mayor's Office that the Commonwealth Gas Company has received a grant for the purpose of examining certain public buildings to determine the energy efficiency of those buildings; and

WHEREAS: The eligible buildings must fall into one of two categories:

- "gas heated buildings housing charitable or non-profit institutions providing food and shelter to the disadvantaged and homeless,"
- "gas heated and publicly subsidized nursing homes and/or elderly housing projects, "

and

WHEREAS: The Commonwealth Gas Company, in cooperation with the MassSave Program, will inspect each eligible building, conduct an energy audit, determine any energy saving steps, and completely provide the personnel, materials and supervision for the implementation of those steps; now therefore be it

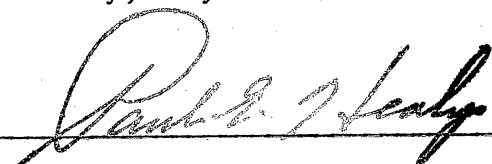
ORDERED: That the City Manager instruct the Commissioner of Public Works, the Assistant City Manager for Human Services, and the Commissioner of Health and Hospitals to compile a list of buildings (and contact persons for each building) that, to the best of their knowledge, would be eligible for this program; and be it further

ORDERED: That this list be provided to the Mayor's Office no later than Wednesday, February 27, 1985.
