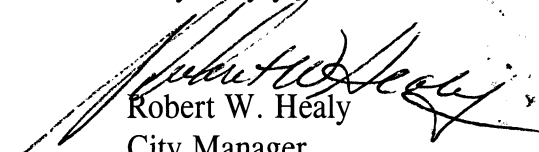

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$43,589 in the grant fund of the Human Services Salary & Wages Account (\$38,463) and the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$5,126) from the Massachusetts Department of Education through the Cambridge Housing Authority (CHA). The Massachusetts Department of Education has granted an increase to the CHA for the adult basic education program that is subcontracted to the Community Learning Center. These funds will be used to provide ESL, computer and writing classes to CHA residents and to develop curriculum. Classes are held at Jefferson Park and Newtowne Court.
