Please find for your review and action an appropriation of \$22,000.00 to the grant fund Human Services Other Ordinary Maintenance Account for the Massachusetts Highway Department.

The purpose of these funds is to provide oversight, evaluation, and program support to the partners in the Cambridge Central Artery/Tunnel Project (CA/T) Collaborative: ERI, Computer-Ed, and East End House and to increase placements of CA/T participants through collaboration with the Cambridge Employment Program.

These funds will be subcontracted to support the Cambridge Employment Program (CEP). CEP provides free job search assistance to Cambridge residents, as well as personalized support in drafting resumes, preparing for interviews, and contracting employers. CEP receives client referrals from a number of Cambridge-based agencies, such as the Multi-Service Center and the Community Learning Center and, in turn, refers residents to appropriate educational or support services that will enhance their employability.
