RESOLUTION APPROVING AND PROVIDING FOR EXECUTION OF AN
AMENDATORY CONTRACT AMENDING THE CONTRACT FOR
COMMUNITY RENEWAL PROGRAM GRANT NO. MASS. R- $\frac{1}{2}$ 33(CR)(G)
BETWEEN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

WHEREAS:

A Contract for Community Renewal Program Grant No. Mass. R-133 (CR)(G) (herein called the "Contract") was duly entered into by the City Council of the City of Cambridge (herein called the "Government") on the 11th day of December, 1967, providing for the financing of the preparation of a Community Renewal Program for the City of Cambridge; and

WHEREAS:

Said Contract was thereafter duly amended on the 30th day of September, 1971, to authorize expenditures not to exceed \$743,921.00 pursuant to said Contract; and

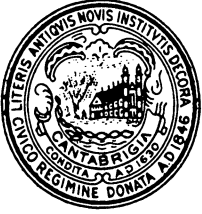
WHEREAS:

The Public Body and the Government now desire to increase the authorized amount for said Contract; now therefore be it

RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That said Contract, amended, be further amended by deleting from Section 1 of Part 1 thereof the amount \$743,921.00 and substituting therefore the amount \$769,221.00.
2. That this Resolution shall take effect immediately.

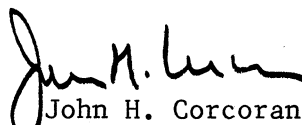
Dear Councillors:
