

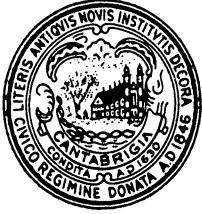

Subject	Rubbish Collections		

The following changes are proposed for rubbish collections in order to provide a cleaner city.

1. Rubbish routes will be revised to provide a more consistent collection system throughout the city. This change may cause some inconvenience until we can determine the best routes. I propose to publish these changes in the newspapers.
2. The rubbish from the schools and public buildings will be collected at night.
3. The litter baskets from the Squares and other congested areas will be collected at night. Additional collections will be made during the daytime and on weekends. The Squares will be picked up twice daily.

To the Honorable, the City Council:

As a follow up to recent discussions with the City Council concerning operations at the Public Works Department, I am pleased to advise you that there will be some changes made in order to better accomplish Public Works Department's tasks, as follows:

1. Rubbish routes will be revised to provide a more consistent collection system throughout the City. This change may cause some inconveniences until the the best routes can be determined. Changes in this regard will be published in the newspaper.
2. Collection of rubbish from schools and public buildings will be accomplished in the early evening to effectively better utilization of equipment and manpower.
3. Litter baskets in the squares and other congested areas will also be collected at night. Additional collections will be made on these same litter baskets during daylight hours and on weekends. All public squares will have two collections each day from this time forward.

I believe these suggestions are notable and I have encouraged Mr. Fagone to proceed with the changes which he has recommended to me.

I submit this information to you to keep your Honorable Body informed of policy changes which are aimed at improving the service to our citizens.
