An Ordinance relating to the compensation of the Driver and Members of the Hook and Ladder Company, and the forfeiture of compensation by Members of the Fire Department.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge.

Section 1. Section forty one of chapter ten of the Revised Ordinances is so amended, that from and after the first day of March 1872 the Driver of the Hook and Ladder Company shall be paid Seventy Five Dollars ^{per} month, and the Members of said Company shall be paid One Hundred Dollars per year, payable monthly.

Section 2. Section fifteen of said chapter is amended by repealing all of said section after the words "one year" in the fourth line.
