I am a lifetime resident of East Cambridge and one of seven children of imigrant parents. I assumed the responsibilities of the male head of the household at age sixteen when my father died. I married Mary Troiano in 1937 and we are the parents of seven children ranging in age from seven years to 27 years. I now support my family through the propriotorship and management of a variety store and through real estate.

Educational Background:

Attended Putnam Grammar School and Rindge Technical High School. Left in my junior year at age 16 to begin working to support my family. I subsequently received a High School diploma from the Cambridge Evening School in 1941.
1948: graduated from an accredited course in public speaking at the Ponte School of Oratory.
1956--57: attended Massachusetts State extension course in English Literature and mathematics.
1956: attended Rhode Island School of Design taking courses in layout and design of industrial machinery.
1957: attended Northeastern University taking courses in industrial management, focusing on time study techniques.
1958: graduated from Lee Institute in Realty Management and subsequently attained a realty broker's licence in 1959.

1936--1938: worked in the WPA and ERA.
1938--40: route driver for the Venice Laundry.
1940-42: machine operator (lathes, drill presses, milling machines) for Cambridge Screw Co.

1942--48: Manager of Bogen Screw Machine Products, Hyde Park, Boston. Managed firm and supervised 10 employees in a war production operation.

1956 to present: self-employed as owner and manager of Adario's Variety and as a licensed realty broker.

1954 to present: President and active member of the 202 Association, a local civic and social organization.

1965: Member of the Executive Committee of the Cambridge Economic Opportunity Committee's East Cambridge Planning Team.

1967: Appointed as East Cambridge representative to the Board of Directors of Cambridge Legal Services, Inc., an OEO-funded legal services program.

Served as a member of the Personnel Practices and Space Committee of the Board of Directors.

1967: Appointed co-chairman of the East Cambridge Planning Team's Community Development Task Force with responsibility for developing a design proposal for a \$1,000,000 recreation complex in East Cambridge.

December 1967: Elected in neighborhood-wide voting to the Presidency of the East Cambridge Planning Team with responsibility for coordinating and developing local components of the Community Action Program sponsored by the Cambridge Economic Opportunity Committee, Inc.

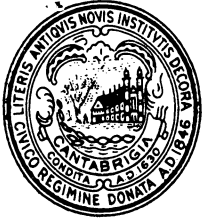
