And the petitioner is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof at least once 14 days prior to said date in the Belmont Citizen and Cambridge Chronicle and to serve a copy hereof at least 14 days prior to said date on Chairman of the Board of Selectmen of Belmont and Mayor and City Clerk of Cambridge and by posting a copy hereof in and on the station buildings named in said petition for a period of 30 days immediately preceding the date of hearing and to make return of service and publication at the time of hearing.



Petition of Cambridge Electric Light Company for authority (1) to issue 5,000 additional shares of its common stock having a par value of \$25.00 per share to sell said stock at a price of \$100.00 per share and to apply the proceeds therefrom in partial reimbursement of amounts borrowed from the Plant Replacement Fund; (2) to issue and sell notes for a term not exceeding thirty years in the aggregate principal amount of \$4,500,000, to bear a rate of interest consistent with the going rate for such securities at the time of issuance determined by competitive bidding and to apply the proceeds therefrom to pay outstanding borrowings incurred for purpose of temporarily financing extensions additions and improvements to the Company's plant and properties.

Upon the foregoing petition, the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, on Monday the 18th day of November, 1957 at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon.

And the petitioner is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least 14 days prior to said date in the Cambridge Chronicle and Sun and to serve a copy hereof by registered mail at least 14 days prior to said date on Mayor and City Clerk of City of Cambridge and Chairman of Board of Selectmen and Town Clerk of Town of Belmont. and to make return of service and publication at the time of hearing.
