WHEREAS: Said sign will be replaced by a much smaller sign located at the existing light fixture at the corner of Massachusetts Avenue and Dunster Street; and

WHEREAS: The new sign will be 13 square feet; and

WHEREAS: The old sign is 156 square feet; and

WHEREAS: Many residents of Cambridge are supportive of the smaller sign; and

WHEREAS: Harvard will need a variance; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to notify the Zoning Board that when Harvard applies for a variance, that the City Council wishes to be recorded in favor.
