WHEREAS:-

It has come to the attention of the City Council that the General Manager of the Metropolitan Transit Authority, Thomas J. McLernon, has indicated his intention of closing the Lechmere Station in East Cambridge, and

WHEREAS:-

The closing of this station, if put into effect, would cause great inconvenience to both the citizens of East Cambridge and Somerville thereby causing them to seek alternate methods of transportation at a substantial loss of revenue to the Metropolitan Transit Authority, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That the City Council of the City of Cambridge go on record as being opposed to the closing of the Lechmere Station, and be it further

ORDERED:-

That Chairman Anthony Pompeo and General Manager, Thomas J. McLernon be invited to attend the next meeting of the City Council on May 22, 1961 and be prepared to discuss the aforesaid matter and all other matters concerning the operation of the Metropolitan Transit Authority as it affects the City of Cambridge.
