Be it ordained by the City Council of
the City ~~Council~~ of Cambridge, as follows,

Section Eight of Chapter Twentyfive of the
Revised Ordinances is hereby amended, by
adding thereto the words

And in case of the blockade or
obstruction of any street, lane or alley, he
shall cause a notification of such block-
ade or obstruction to be left at each
of the several engine houses throughout
the City.
