That the City Manager be, and hereby is, requested to ask the Department of Traffic and Parking to negotiate with private organizations which operate parking garages (for example, Mount Auburn Hospital and Harvard University) with a view to having these garages open for parking for Cambridge citizens who live nearby at little or no cost for night and week-end parking throughout the year, and during snowstorms. Such investigation and report shall be requested to be made within thirty days to the City Council through its subcommittee on transportation.
