Petition of the Eastern Massachusetts Street Railway Company that the Department amend common carrier certificate No. 3348 issued in D.P.U. No. 14389 on October 16, 1963 authorizing the petitioner to carry passengers for hire over routes in the cities of Woburn, Medford, Somerville and Cambridge and the towns of Andover, North Reading, Tewksbury, Wilmington, Reading, Stoneham and Winchester by striking the following restriction contained therein:

"PROVIDED: That operation under this license shall be valid only during such period of time as an agreement entered into between Eastern Massachusetts Street Railway Company and the Mass Transportation Commission, dated July 30, 1963, shall remain in force and effect."

Upon the foregoing petition the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, on Thursday, January 30, 1964 at 10 o'clock in the forenoon.
