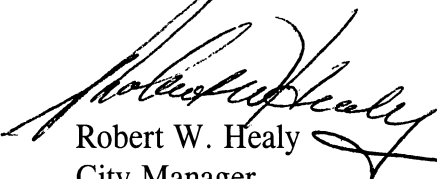

To the Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$4,415.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$250.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$4,165) from the Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development for use by the Low Income Sewer and Water Assistance Program (LISAWAP). LISAWAP, operated by DHSP, is available to Cambridge homeowners whose income falls at or below 150% of poverty according to Federal guidelines. Eligible clients can receive 25% or \$200, whichever is less, toward their annual water and sewer bill. The funding is provided by the Massachusetts Department of Community Development.
