WHEREAS: During September through June, when the City Council meets every Monday except for Monday Holidays, applications for temporary street obstruction by means of the nonprofit agencies and city departments, by means of A-framed signs, tables and chairs, display of merchandise, are referred by the City Council to the City Manager with authority to act on said applications; and

WHEREAS: During the summer, the City Council generally only meets one time, which can create delay for merchants and organizations applying for such temporary obstruction; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That during the summer, after the final June meeting and prior to the first September meeting, all applications for temporary street obstructions are hereby referred to the City Manager with authorization to act; and be it further

ORDERED: That application from non-profit organizations and agencies for temporary banners across the public way with no commercial advertising messages are hereby referred to the City Manager with authorization to act during the same summer time period; and be it further

ORDERED: That this order shall be considered a standing order of the City Council and shall remain in effect unless and until nullified by further action of the City Council.

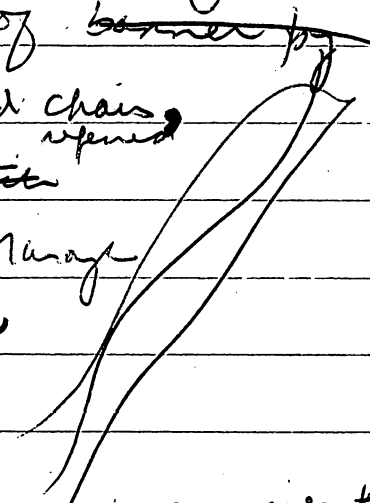
