Raising the wire higher in the air will necessitate
trimming the trees in the public streets, under the
circumstances in which I am placed the trees being the
property of the City of Cambridge there can be no objection
to trimming them sufficient to clear the wires for
other wise twigs and limbs lying on the wires render
the line of little value. Have the kindness to arrange
so that the fire dept. will care for the 25 ft. poles
as soon as they are taken down. I sincerely
hope nothing will occur to prevent ~~us~~ having
the right of way to Harvard Sq. On this loop
we shall be obliged to use covered wire
which on a main line would be impracticable.
