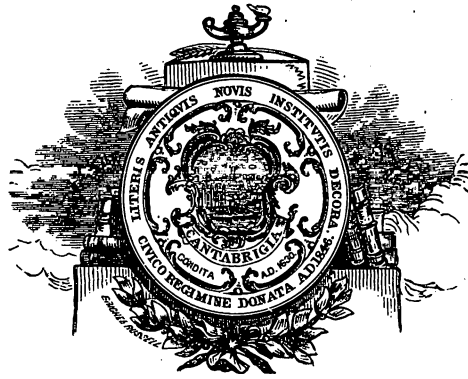


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.



In Board of Aldermen, April 1st 1874

Resolved, That the public convenience and necessity require that *Linnean Street* from North Avenue to Garden Street should be widened in certain parts thereof and laid out of a uniform width,

by taking for this purpose certain parcels of land, as shown on a plan prepared by the City Engineer, and now before this Board.

Therefore, Ordered, that so much of the land on *Linnean Street* between North Avenue and Garden Street

as is included between the *red* lines shown on a plan of *Linnean* Street, drawn by the City Engineer, dated April 1st 1874 and now before this Board, be taken for public use, and laid out as a public way and a part of said *Linnean* Street.

Ordered, That damages occasioned by said *widening* be estimated

and awarded as follows:

Ordered, That *Thirty Days*, be allowed to the persons whose land is
taken for said *widening* for the removal of *their fences &c.* standing
on the land so taken as aforesaid.
