- WHEREAS: The team will be skating in France and Switzerland during the April school vacation, competing against the French and Swiss National teams as well as against regional all-star teams; and
- WHEREAS: The team is the first state-wide all star women's ice hockey team in the United States and players were chosen at special try-outs by the Amateur Hockey Association of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts; and
- WHEREAS: Sarah, at fourteen, is the youngest member of the team whose players range from fourteen to nineteen; and
- WHEREAS: Sarah began her ice hockey career with the Cambridge Youth Hockey Program six years ago at the age of eight; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council congratulate Sarah Hsia for her outstanding accomplishment in qualifying for this team; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That Sarah be authorized to wear "the City of Cambridge" on her game shirt during the competition this spring.
