In order to comply with this request, it is essential that you obtain written permission from the owners of the buildings to which the banner will be attached.

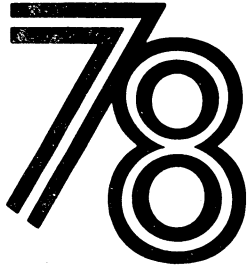
Your compliance with this request will enable the City Council to issue an appropriate order.
