As you know, State Auditor Finnegan, under the provisions of Chapter 580 of the Acts of 1980 (better known as Proposition 2 1/2), is charged with the responsibility of ensuring that there are no laws enacted nor rules and regulations promulgated by state government that impose additional costs upon cities and towns without providing for the assumption of these costs.

Because so many communities have expressed concern about the fiscal impact of recent laws such as REAP, RIGHT TO KNOW and the JAIL SUICIDE PREVENTION ACT, as well as new legislative proposals for educational reform and binding arbitration, the Auditor has been asked to meet with local officials.

Please extend this invitation to any department heads or committee members you deem appropriate to come and participate in this session with Auditor Finnegan.
