

City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, June 21, 1871.

Ordered, That, until otherwise ordered, the form, size and material of street-numbers, and the mode and place of affixing the same be left to the discretion of the owners or occupants of dwelling-houses and other buildings; and that the City Engineer be, and he hereby is, instructed to notify the owners or occupants of buildings in this City to cause numbers to be affixed to the same, forthwith, as the same are designated on the plans made by him for that purpose, and now in his custody.
