ORDERED:

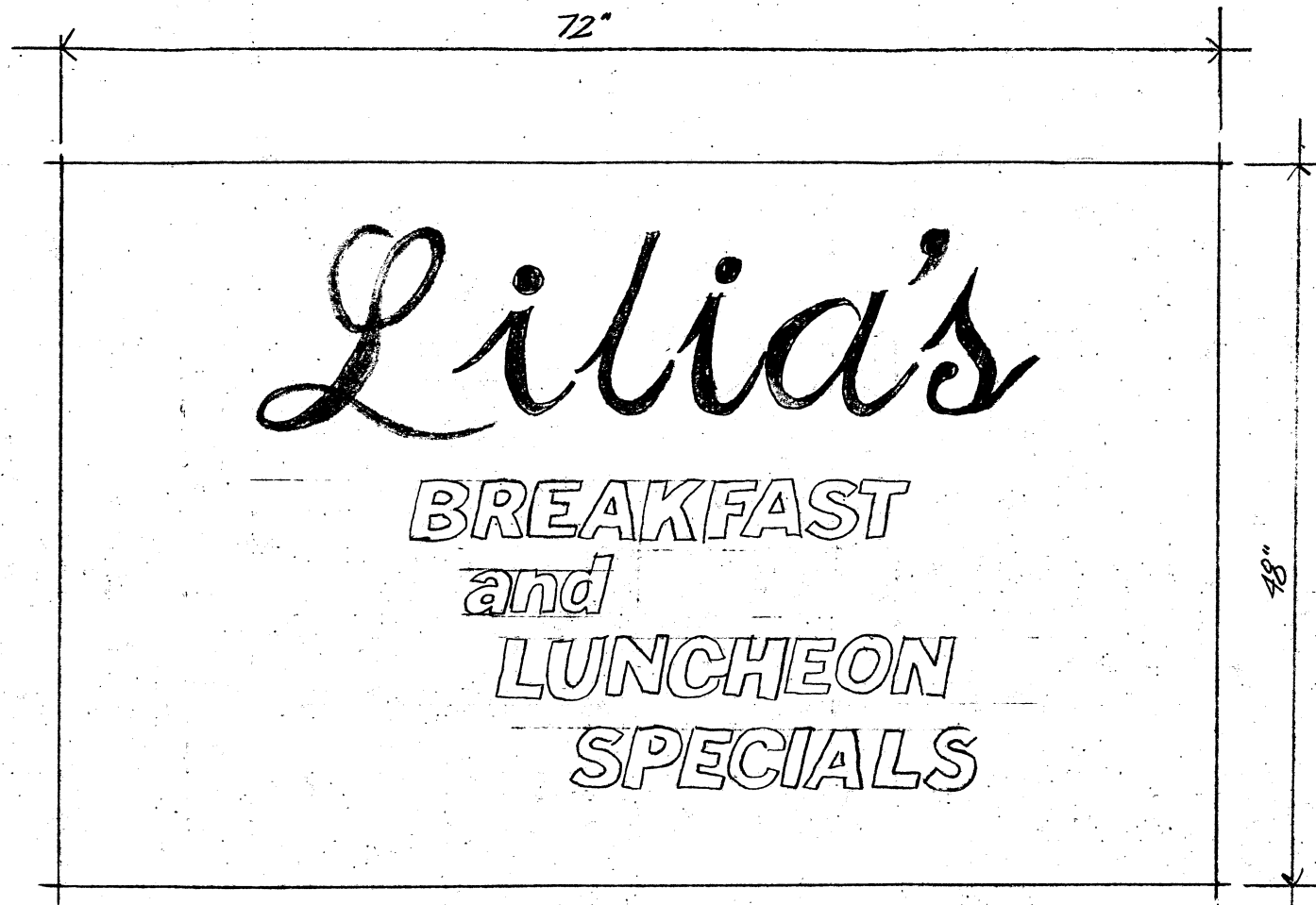

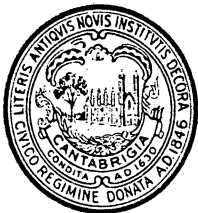
