Space Opera is a light hearted show for family audiences inspired by the first Star Wars movie (Episode IV). It was first performed last May by a cast consisting of children and adults from North Cambridge and surrounding communities. This year's production is much more ambitious. We will perform the entire opera (last year's show was somewhat abridged), with elaborate costumes and sets and with a completely reorchestrated MIDI score.
