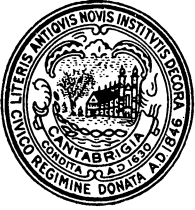

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$384.75 to reimburse Anthony Pacheco, an employee of the Public Works Department for damages in this amount.

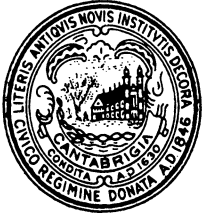


