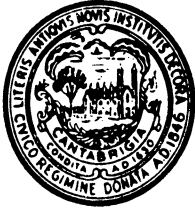

The Community Development Department, the Department of Traffic, Parking and Transportation, and the Central Square Business Association have been exploring and evaluating management plans for the maintenance of the Central Square Improvements once the project is complete. The new bus stop shelters located mid block between Prospect and Essex Street northbound on Massachusetts Avenue, and eastbound on Massachusetts Avenue at the corner of Pearl Street are structures that will be owned and maintained by the City. In developing an overall management plan, every effort will be made to ensure that the bus shelters do not significantly impact businesses and patrons of businesses in the same area. The maintenance of the Central Square Improvements Phase II, which includes all of Massachusetts Avenue and the side streets, will be managed by the Department of Public Works.
