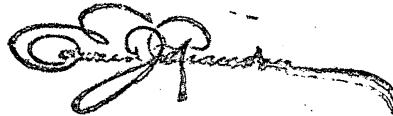

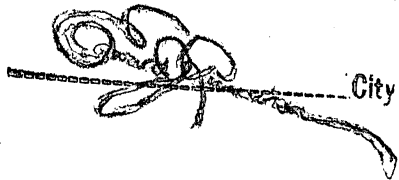

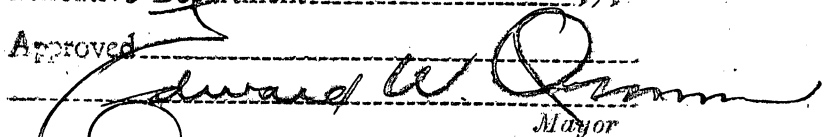
On Rogers Street, westerly from the present sewer a distance of about 80 feet.

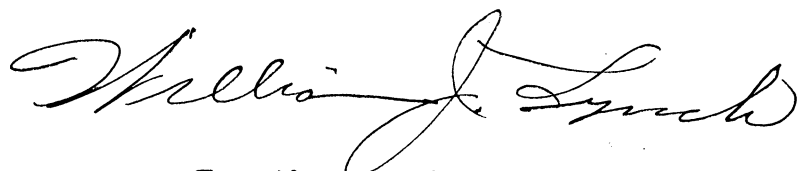
