Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

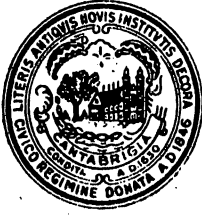

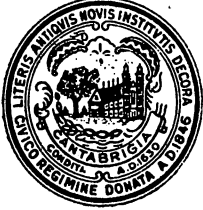


The Ordinance
