Retired legislative agent

Daniel F. Connelly, retired publicist and legislative agent for Commonwealth Gas and Energy Systems, died of cancer Tuesday at his home in Winchester. He was 72.

Born and educated in Cambridge, Mr. Connelly served in the Army during World War II. He was a past exalted ruler of Cambridge Lodge of Elks, a director of the Ancient Order of Hibernians and the first president of the Cambridge Housing Convention, an advocacy group.

He leaves his wife, Florence D. (Kenney); a daughter, Gail Strang of Billerica; two sons, Daniel F. Jr. of Merrimack, N.H., and Stephen D. of Londonderry, N.H.; a brother, Richard of Arlington; a sister, Catherine Gordon of South Yarmouth; and six grandchildren.

A funeral Mass will be said tomorrow at 10 a.m. in St. Peter's Church, Cambridge. Burial will be in Cambridge Cemetery.
