"CAMBRIDGE PLAN"

Statement of Purpose

Under the auspices of the Human Services and Youth Committee of the City Council, the City will develop a human services policy which best serves the needs of Cambridge's residents in changing economic times and which insures the most effective provision of human services in the City.

The purpose of the "Cambridge Plan" is to bring together providers of human services, including non-profit agencies and the City, to work collaboratively in developing a blueprint for a healthy Cambridge. The primary consideration in this blueprint should be the human services needs of individuals and families in the community.

In a time of scarce resources, this implies the willingness of both providers and the City as a funder to re-examine existing patterns of service provision and resource allocation. All parties to the Plan will work toward establishing service priorities to guide future funding decisions and inter-relationships of service providers with each other and funders. City policy for human services will directly relate to the "Cambridge Plan".
