Whereas: We seek a revitalized, thriving Cambridgeport area.

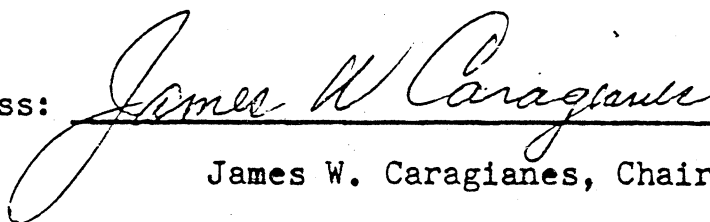
Therefore Be It Resolved:
