To the Honorable, the City Council:

I herewith submit to the City Council a request to comply with the State Department of Revenue's requirements that a two-thirds vote be obtained from the local appropriating authority in order to exceed the gross levy limit and the appropriation limit of 4%. The "levy" being referred to is not the levy as defined on the tax rate recapitulation sheet. The "levy" as it applies to the tax cap is the gross amount to be raised less certain excluded items. The appropriation limit is 4% of last year's appropriation level less certain excluded items.


A two-thirds vote is required to exceed the levy limit by the amount of \$4,237,412.72.

A two-thirds vote is required to exceed the appropriation limit by the amount of \$3,870,394.00.

A two-thirds vote is also required to exceed the School Department appropriation cap by the amount of \$8,055,105.42.

These three votes are necessary in order to set the tax rate and mail out the tax bills in a timely manner to avoid excess interest payments.
