Petition of the Eastern Massachusetts Street Railway Company for determination by the Department of Public Utilities that public convenience and necessity require the petitioner to operate motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire over the following routes in the following communities:

Cambridge: On Somerville Avenue between Massachusetts Avenue and the Somerville-Cambridge boundary line.
On Hampshire Street between the Somerville-Cambridge boundary line and Broadway.

Somerville: On Somerville Avenue between the Cambridge-Somerville line and Beacon Street.
On Beacon Street between Somerville Avenue and the Cambridge-Somerville boundary line.

Upon the foregoing petition the Department of Public Utilities will hold a public hearing at its hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, on Thursday, January 30, 1964 at 10 o'clock in the forenoon.
