WHEREAS: In June 2003, Cambridge College announced the appointment of Provost and Executive Vice President Mahesh C. Sharma as its second President and the appointment of President Eileen Moran Brown as Chancellor/Founder, effective July 1, 2003; and

WHEREAS: Chancellor Brown and a small group of colleagues developed the unique adult-learning model that is the hallmark of Cambridge College. She nurtured the college through its formative years and, in partnership with Provost Sharma, oversaw the growth of the college and its many new programs. In the last ten years, enrollment has increased from 1,425 students a year to over 5,000 students, and the college's budget has grown from \$9 million to \$36 million; and

WHEREAS: President Sharma has been associated with Cambridge College for over twenty-five years, including as Dean in 1992 and Provost in 2000. He is responsible for the success and growth of the National Institute for Teaching Excellence (NITE) program that has made the college a national leader in the education and training of public school teachers; and

WHEREAS: President Sharma is known world-wide for his innovative techniques for teaching mathematics to all ages, and for his pioneering work in this field, including the development of a unique educational system called Vertical Acceleration, which enables students to fill gaps in their learning quickly. President Sharma has served as a consultant to scores of school systems throughout the world and has taught at several institutions of higher learning in Asia and Europe; and

WHEREAS: Cambridge College will hold an inauguration ceremony and reception in honor of President Sharma and Chancellor Brown on Tuesday, September 23, 2003 at 6:30 P.M. at the Hyatt Regency in Cambridge; now therefore be it
