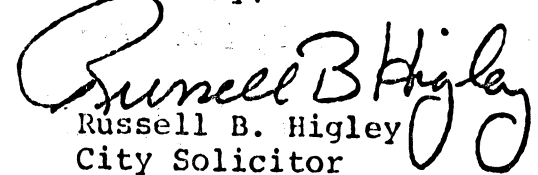

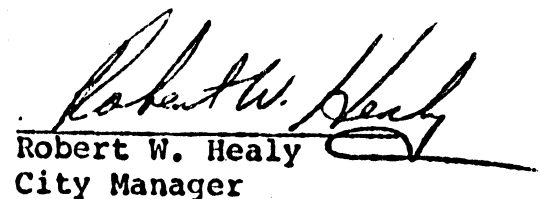
Dear Mr. Samp:
