COUNCILLOR VELLUCCI

ORDERED: That it is the policy of this City Council that the Cambridge Housing Authority construct housing for the elderly of Cambridge at the location of the former Putnam School after the Housing Authority has met with the residents of the East Cambridge/Putnam School area to decide on the number of units and only after the Housing Authority agrees to the following conditions:-

1. That no dumpster for rubbish or trash of any kind be located on this site.
2. That they provide adequate parking for this elderly development based upon a survey which should be conducted in conjunction with the neighborhood residents and the Department of Traffic and Parking, and
3. That Cambridge residents be given preference in the selection process.
