- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Mahla (Molly) Shuman Aronson, R.N., a Nurse at the Cambridge Hospital for thirty-five years, holding varying positions of responsibility throughout that time, will soon retire; and
- WHEREAS: Molly entered the Cambridge City Hospital School of Nursing in 1936 and upon graduation in 1939, she began work as a General Duty Nurse at the Cambridge Hospital and the Beth Israel Hospital, where she worked for a year prior to joining the United States Army Nurse Corps; and
- WHEREAS: Molly served her country during World War II, spending over three years in Australia, New Caledonia and New Zealand, and in 1944 received an Honorable Discharge with the rank of First Lieutenant; and
- WHEREAS: Molly, shortly after her discharge from the Army, married Herman Aronson and they were blessed with a son, Arthur; and
- WHEREAS: In 1952, Molly rejoined the Cambridge Hospital as a General Duty Nurse, working from 1952 to 1962 with diabetic patients and their families, and she also spent much time teaching both nursing and medical students about diabetes; and
- WHEREAS: Molly has, for the past twenty-two years, had primary responsibility for Pediatric Clinics in the Outpatient Department, taking care of second generation Cambridge residents, in come cases; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere best wishes and its debt of gratitude to Mahla "Molly" Aronson for her tireless efforts on behalf of so many Cambridge children for thirty-five years, and to further extend to her every good wish for much good health and happiness as she embarks on a new phase of her life; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Molly on behalf of the entire City Council.

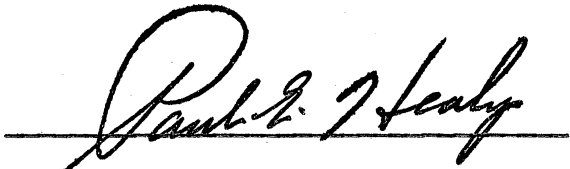
