COUNCILLOR WALSH

WHEREAS: Due to truck presence and newly installed air conditioners at the site of Star Market at Porter Square, residents who live adjacent thereto are experiencing severe noise impact and all indications suggest that there is a very serious disparity between the noise level emanating from the site and the noise level allowed under the city's Noise Ordinance, either the Noise Ordinance is being enforced and given compliance with uniformity, or it is not and the residents have a right to be protected, not at some future date in the winter or beyond, but now from what appears to be a gross violation of the city's Noise Ordinance; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That, on or before September 25, 1989, the City Manager report to the City Council and advise as to the steps being taken presently to insure that Star Market, in all of its activities and dimensions, is in full compliance with the dictates of the city's Noise Ordinance and, absent said compliance, specify to the City Council what counter measures have been initiated by the appropriate city officials.
