IN CITY COUNCIL

September 24, 1979

ORDERED: That a license be and hereby is granted to Sansone Motors, Inc. of Norwood, Massachusetts under the provisions of Chapter 159A of the Massachusetts General Laws for the operation of motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers through the following streets and ways in Cambridge:

On Cambridge Route 2; along River Street, between Allston Line and Western Avenue; along Western Avenue, between River Street and Massachusetts Avenue; along Massachusetts Avenue, between Western Avenue and Main Street; along Main Street, between Massachusetts Avenue and Portland Street; along Portland Street, between Main Street and Cambridge Street; along Cambridge Street, between Portland Street and Msgr. O'Brien Highway; along Msgr. O'Brien Highway, between Cambridge Street and Charles River Dam Road; along River Street, between Allston Line and Western Avenue; along Western Avenue, between River Street and Prospect Street; along Prospect Street, between River Street and Cambridge Street; along Cambridge Street, between Prospect Street and Msgr. O'Brien Highway; along Msgr. O'Brien Highway, between Cambridge Street and Charles River Dam Road.

This permit is granted subject to the condition that NO pick ups will take place in the City of Cambridge, with the exception of Accoustical Research of Norwood.

This petition for a license is granted subject to the approval of the City Manager.

Provided further that the petitioner provide the City Clerk with a schedule of the vehicles to be used and a schedule of the departure and arrival times for the above described route.

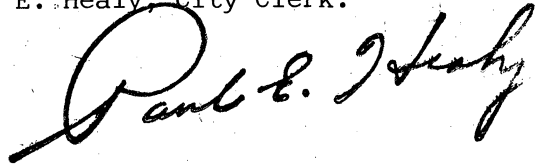
Violation of any of the conditions outlined above will be the cause for the revocation of this license.

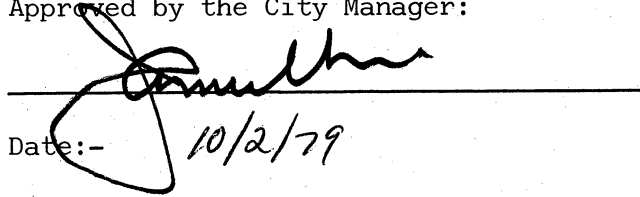

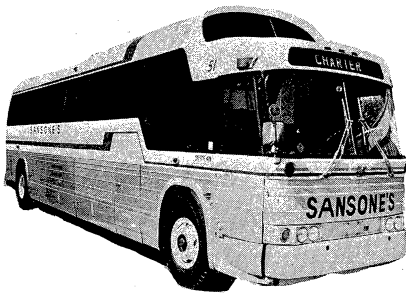

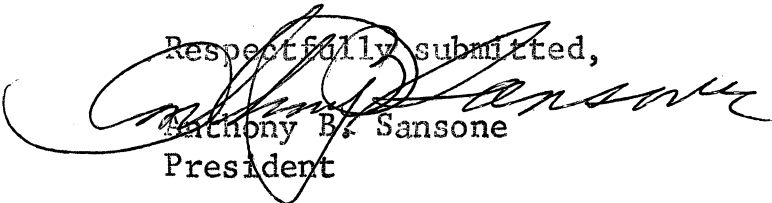

Along River St., between Allston Line and Western Ave.
Along Western Ave., between River St. & Prospect St.
Along Prospect St., between River St. & Cambridge St.
Along Cambridge St., between Prospect St. & Msgr. O'Brien Hwy.
Along Msgr. O'Brien Hwy., between Cambridge St. & Charles River Dam Rd.
