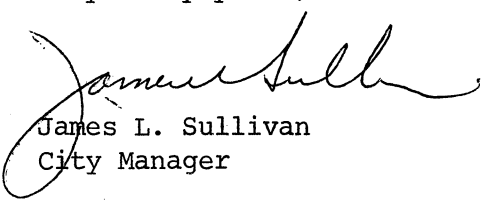

To the Honorable, the City Council:

With respect to Awaiting Report Item No. 3 regarding the re-location of the Engineering Department, please be advised as follows:

Under the Local Public Works Act, Phase II, the City is constructing an addition to the Public Works building on Hampshire Street. Since engineering work is most closely associated with public works projects, it will be a logistical advantage to have the Engineering Department located in the Public Works building. The move will take place upon completion of the Public Works addition. Concurrently it is also a logistical improvement to have the Election Commission located in the primary municipal building, i.e. City Hall. Thus, when Engineering moves to Public Works, the Election Commission will move to suitable space in City Hall.
