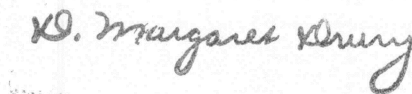

Math teacher in Needham; at 71

A memorial Mass will be said on Saturday for Sister Evelyn Catherine Barrett of the Dominican Sisters of the Congregation of St. Catherine of Siena, who died of cancer Dec. 3 in the order's motherhouse in St. Catherine, Ky. She was 71.

Sister Evelyn Catherine taught mathematics at St. Sebastian Country Day School in Needham for the past 15 years. She had previously been principal of Sacred Heart High School in East Boston and taught at St. Francis de Sales School in Charlestown, North Cambridge Catholic High School and Mt. Trinity Academy in Watertown.

Born in North Cambridge, she earned a bachelor's degree in mathematics at Siena College in Memphis and a master's degree at the University of Notre Dame.

A Dominican sister for 51 years, she spent many summers ministering in Chimbote, Peru.

The memorial Mass will be said at 10 a.m. in Rosary Manor Chapel in Watertown. Burial was in the Dominican Sisters Cemetery in St. Catherine, Ky.
