- WHEREAS: On April 9, 1978 Pasquale was appointed as Acting Lieutenant for Engine Company No. 8 and was subsequently promoted to Lieutenant on October 29, 1978; and
- WHEREAS: Pasquale had a temporary assignment to the School Department on December 2, 1979; and
- WHEREAS: On July 6, 1980 Pasquale was assigned to Engine Company No. 1; and
- WHEREAS: Pasquale was promoted to Captain of Engine Company No. 1 on May 9, 1982; and
- WHEREAS: On January 2, 1983 Pasquale was assigned to Civil Defense and later assigned to Engine Company No. 4 on February 27, 1983; Engine Company No. 7 on April 17, 1983; Pivot Officer, Headquarters on July 1, 1983; Engine Company No. 3 on April 24, 1994 and Engine Company No. 9 on October 10, 1994; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record expressing its appreciation to Pasquale J. DeMaio for his forty-one years of dedicated service to the citizens and to the City of Cambridge and wish him much happiness in his retirement; and be it further
