To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$716,419.00 in the grant fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$112,482.00) and the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$603,937.00) from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services through the Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development. The Cambridge/Somerville Low Income Heating Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is operated by the Department of Human Service Programs. The program serves 3,000 clients in both cities, including 1,400 Cambridge residents. Benefit levels this year will range from \$40 to \$480 per household depending on income level and household characteristics. These funds will be used cover administration of the program and to provide benefits.
