- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened at learning of the death of Paul Roazen on November 7, 2005; and
- WHEREAS: Paul was born in Boston in 1936 and received his undergraduate degree in government from Harvard College in 1958. He studied at the University of Chicago, Oxford University, and again at Harvard University, where he received his doctorate in 1965; and
- WHEREAS: Paul taught in the Government Department at Harvard from 1965 to 1971 and was a professor emeritus of political science at York University in Toronto; he taught at York University from 1971 to 1995; and
- WHEREAS: Paul was a noted historian of the psychoanalytic movement and the author of numerous books on Sigmund Freud and his followers; he was the author of 22 books and hundreds of articles, reviews and essays; and
- WHEREAS: Paul was the dear father of Jules Roazen and Daniel Roazen; and
- WHEREAS: Paul was the loving brother of Bernard Roazen and Sheila Weiss; and
- WHEREAS: Paul's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family and friends; and
- WHEREAS: Paul will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Paul Roazen at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Roazen family on behalf of the entire City Council.
