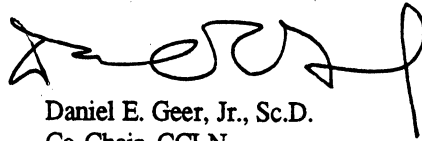

We wish to object in advance to any approval of commercial parking arrangements at your meeting of September 26th, 1989. Per your agenda, parking for 292 vehicles in three facilities is to be discussed. As we have stated repeatedly, the City appears to be in violation of the SIP and the letter of understanding between Messrs. Pope, Laing and Drisdell, and you are likely taking actions for which you have no authority.
