RESOLVED: That the City Council of Cambridge, Massachusetts, U.S.A., hereby resolves to request appropriate officials of Uganda to make public the reasons for the arrests of Jaberu Bidandi-Sali, Mrs. Rhoda Misibirwa Kalema, Rev. Christopher Okoth, Professor Yoweri Kyesimira, and Dr. E.G.N. Muzira, and to advise whether the rights of those persons are being observed under the United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights. As elected governmental officials in a democratic society, the Cambridge City Councillors wish to say to Uganda officials that governmental service should never result in the violation of a person's liberty, and further that disregard of the personal rights of members of a political opposition creates a destabilizing force in the world.
