(referred to herein as "NET"), has filed with the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") revisions to its tariffs as part of this continuing investigation into a complaint of Teleport Communications-Boston. The tariff revisions are set forth in schedules M.D.P.U. Nos. 10 and 15, filed by NET with the Department on March 19, 1991, to become effective April 18, 1991.

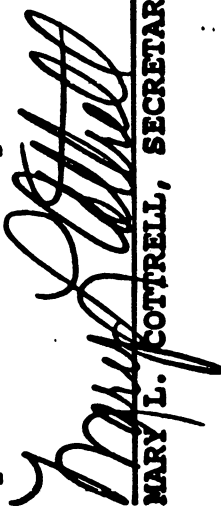
The tariffs filed by NET in this proceeding contain terms and conditions relating to the following: an arrangement whereby a customer may establish a premises within selected NET Central Office buildings at which the customer may place transmission equipment connected to fiber optic facilities; a credit plan on Company services provided to a customer premises within an NET Central Office building; a credit plan on NET business services provided to all customers within the Central and Cambridge exchanges; reductions in Company business toll and switched access rates in Eastern Massachusetts; and increases in business dial tone line rates in exchanges other than the Central and Cambridge exchanges.

In accordance with 220 C.M.R. 1.04(1)(d), written comments on NET's proposed tariff may be filed no later than April 8, 1991, with the Secretary, Department of Public Utilities, 100 Cambridge Street, Room 1210, Boston, Massachusetts 02202. Eight (8) copies of the comments shall be filed with the Secretary. Any person submitting comments must also serve a copy of the comments on all parties of record in this docket.

A public hearing concerning NET's filing will be held at 10:00 a.m. on April 18, 1991, at the Department's offices at Room 1210, Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts.

NET is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof once at least fourteen (14) days prior to said date in the Boston Globe, The Springfield Union News, the Berkshire Gazette (Pittsfield), and The Worcester Telegram, and to serve a copy hereof at least fourteen (14) days prior to said date on those persons listed on the attached list, and to make a return of service and publication, to include original clippings of the newspaper publications, at the time of the hearing.
