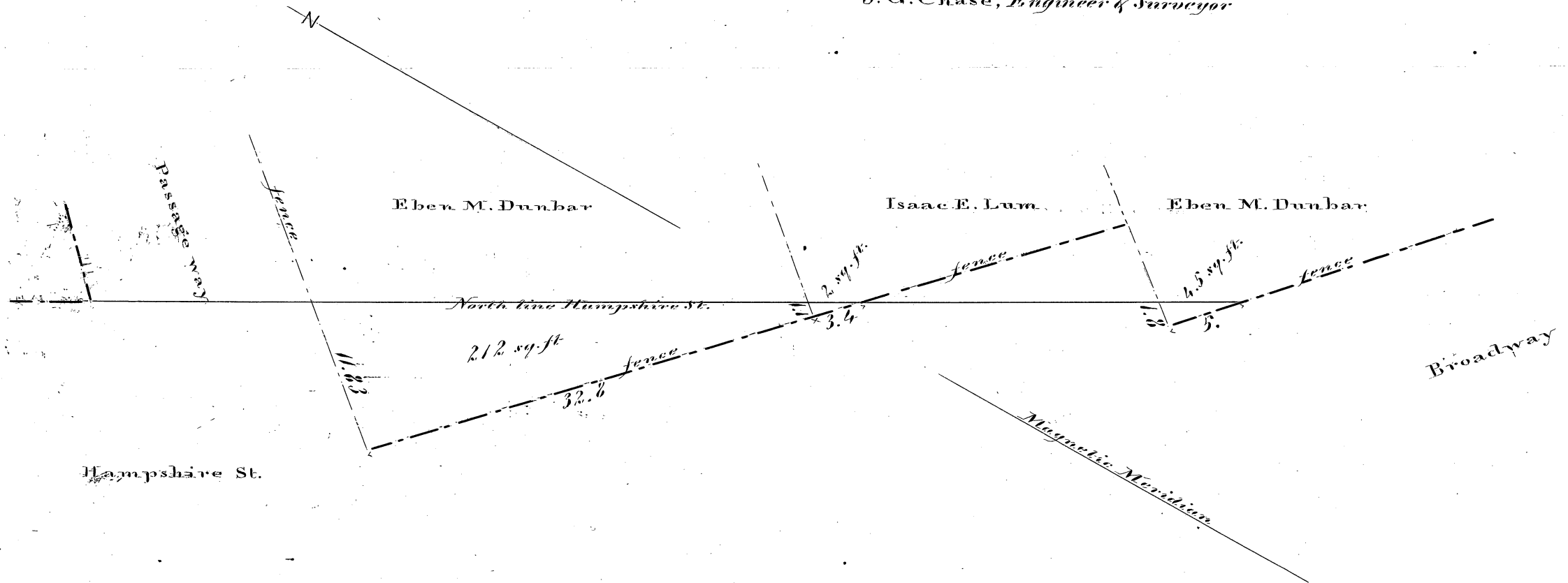


For widening Hampshire St. at junction with Broadway

# City of Cambridge.

In Board of Aldermen, July 11. 1866.

Ordered, That Hampshire Street, near its junction with Broadway, be widened on its North Eastern side by taking three small parcels of land, the first belonging to Eben M. Durbin, ~~the second~~ and containing 212 square feet; - the second belonging to Isaac E. Linn and containing two square feet; - and the third belonging to said Eben M. Durbin and containing four and five-tenths square feet; - all said parcels being delineated on a Plan drawn by J. L. Chase, dated June 1866 - and now before this Board.

Ordered. That the land so taken be laid out as a part of said Hampshire Street and a public highway.

Ordered. That damages for the land so taken be estimated and awarded as follows:-

To Eben M. Durbin, the sum of Seventy five Dollars
